Port Notice 01/2021

Operation of Tug Services at Port of Abbot Point

Definitions in the *Transport Infrastructure Act 1994* (Qld) and the *Transport Infrastructure (Ports) Regulation 2016* (Qld) apply in this port notice.

Pursuant to section 289B of the *Transport Infrastructure Act 1994* (Qld), operating a tug service is a controlled activity. Pursuant to section 282(2)(d), North Queensland Bulk Ports Corporation Limited ACN 136 880 218 (**NQBP**), as the port authority for the Port of Abbot Point, issues this port notice to manage the operation of tug services.

On and from 1 October 2021, no person may engage in the activity of operating a tug service in the port area for the Port of Abbot Point without the prior written approval of NQBP. Contravening this requirement without reasonable excuse is an offence under section 282J of the *Transport Infrastructure Act 1994* (Qld). The maximum penalty for such contravention is 100 penalty units.
