- An area for pedestrian recreational fishing access and
- An area of additional unmarked car and boat trailer parking.

WHY IS ACCESS TO THE ADDITIONAL AREAS ONLY TEMPORARY?


Our ports are crucial trade gateways, driving economic growth, creating jobs, and supporting industries across Queensland and beyond.
